#### President's Message

Yokohama Tyre Vietnam Inc. makes tires for export to Japan and direct sale in domestic markets. Our bias (cross ply) tires are used mainly on motorcycles, small trucks and industrial vehicles. The company has been operating since January 2008, and therefore, we are still relatively young with much to learn. But we are doing well, thanks to the enthusiasm and vitality of our Vietnamese staff and the support of our affiliates and head office in Japan. The general public in Vietnam has recently started to show a deeper interest in the environmental issues. It is

an important first step, but there is still a long way to go. We are working to instil an understanding of the fundamental importance of cleaning, tidiness and discipline as the basis of all indicators used at the Company. In FY2009, the Company took part in various sporting events held in the local region and with affiliated companies. While the results did not always go our way, these events were certainly very successful in terms of forging closer links with the local community.

Since February 2010, we have been preparing our application for ISO14001 certification, involving daily study sessions and preparation of documentation. We plan to obtain certification in November 2010, then continue working to boost our standards using the PDCA cycle. We are also working on preparations for the first phase of planting in the YOKOHAMA Forever Forest project, due to take place in December 2010. As a member of the Yokohama Rubber Group, we have an ongoing commitment to becoming a top-level environmentally responsible enterprise.



The "Stop, Call, Wait" action principles in the FY2010 Health and Safety Program are used to boost safety awareness.



#### **Local donations**

The following donations were made during FY2009.
